### **COVID-19 & Property Taxes**

(Updated 1/20/2021)



#### Do I still have to pay my property taxes during the COVID-19 crisis?

Yes, property taxes are still due during the COVID-19 crisis. There are no late fees through October 1, 2020 on 2019 Second Installment Taxes. Additionally, there will be no late fees charged on 2020 First Installment Taxes through May 3, 2021.

#### What happens if I don't pay my property taxes?

If you do not pay your property taxes, they will be sold at a tax sale. In a tax sale, your taxes will be sold to a private buyer. There is a 2.5 year redemption period. If you do not pay your taxes in full including penalties and interest during the redemption period, the tax buyer can obtain the title to your property and evict you. **Due to the COVID-19 crisis, the next scheduled tax sale has been delayed indefinitely.** 

## What if my property taxes have already been sold--can I still redeem them?

The Real Estate and Tax Services Office of the Cook County Clerk is accepting redemption payments by mail. There is limited public access by appointment only. You may email any questions and/or concerns regarding tax redemptions to tax.redemption@cookcountyil.gov.
