Legal Aid Chicago is seeking current law students to apply for spring internships with one of our practice groups. Duties may include:

- client interviews and case investigation
- memoranda and brief writing
- drafting of pleadings and judgments
- court representation under Illinois Supreme Court Rule 711
- direct representation at administrative hearings
- legal research

Must be available for a **minimum of 10 hours/week** during the semester. Applications processed year-round. Applicants are encouraged to apply early!

As the situation changes, we anticipate that at least a portion of the internship would take place remotely. Applicants wishing to work remotely may apply.

- cover letter (**please indicate preferred practice group**)
- resume
- brief writing sample (2-4 pages)
- law school transcript
- contact information for two professional references
